## In-Person Worship in the Sanctuary and Livestreaming Begins

On November 1, First Church resumed in-person worship in the sanctuary, and we held our first live-streamed worship service. While some worshippers were gathered in the sanctuary, many others were gathered at home and joined the service online in real time.

The live-streaming upgrade that we have been working on for a couple of months was installed on October 22 and training on the system began immediately. The system includes a new sound board, new microphones, additional sound equipment, 2 new video cameras, a unit that receives and sends out the audio/visual content to the internet, and several other technical components.

This live-streaming system allows us to worship together at the same time from many different places. It also allows us to record and keep the services for viewing at a later time. We know that this system is more than electronic equipment, it is a ministry for maintaining spiritual connection and building the kingdom. We are so grateful to those who financially supported this project.

Links to the online services are sent out through email every Saturday night. If you are not already getting these emails, you can sign up for them at http://bit.ly/1stchurchjcemail

Each week, the live-stream feed will begin at about 10:20 with on-screen announcements, giving you plenty of time to find the service and get ready for worship before the service starts at 10:30. During the service, you can use chat or comment features to connect with others, share prayer requests, applaud the musicians, or shout "Amen!"

Though some are currently worshipping in-person in the sanctuary, we strongly encourage those who do not feel safe or comfortable gathering in person to continue to worship at home. The live-streamed services will help keep us connected to God and to one another as we navigate these times.

We hope to see you or be seen by you in person or online.
