Hands-On Mission Project for Holston Conference 2021

First Church has been assigned backpacks for school children in Liberia. Backpacks are **due by May 7, 2021.**

- 1 backpack (new or gently used)
- 1 12" ruler
- 2 boxes chalk
- 1 compass for math
- 1 protractor
- 1 10-12 pack pens (blue or black ink)
- 1 10-12 pack pencils
- 1 pack erasers
- 2 pencil sharpeners
- 3 spiral notebooks (70 ct.)
- 1 small Bible (new or used)

Instructions

- Remove price tags from all items
- Place school supplies inside backpack
- Use only quantities listed (note that 10 or 12 count packs of pens and pencils are allowed)
- No substitutions or additional items are allowed due to Customs regulations, including notes, cards, photos, religious tracts, food items, or anything else not on the list

Please make \$5 donation for each backpack to First Church with the note "LIBERIA BACKPACKS," to help us cover the shipping costs. Do not place donation inside the backpack.

UMCOR Cleaning Buckets

The United Methodist Committee On Relief (UMCOR) works help communities after disasters. Individual and groups are invited to create and bring cleaning kits to First Church by May 7, 2021.

- · One five-gallon round bucket with lid
 - * 14.35" h x 12.19" w x 12.19" d
 - * No screw lids
 - May be used, but must be free from all residual product
 - * Advertisement on the outside acceptable
- One 32-64 oz. bottle liquid laundry detergent
- One 16–40 oz. bottle liquid concentrate household cleaner
 - * No spray cleaners
- One 16-34 oz. bottle liquid dish soap
- One 4–8 oz. pump spray air freshener
- One 6–14 oz. pump spray insect repellant
 - * pack of 10-20 wipes also acceptable
 - * With or without handle
 - Pump spray bottles must have protective covers
- One scrub brush (With or without handle)
- 18 re-usable cleaning wipes
 - * No terrycloth, microfiber or paper towels
 - * Remove from packaging
- Five scouring pads
 - * No stainless steel or pads with soap in them
 - * Remove from packaging
- 36-50 clothespins
- One 50–100 ft. clothesline (Cotton or plastic)
- 24ct Roll of heavy-duty trash bags
 - * 33-45 gallon sizes
 - * Remove from packaging
- Five N95 particulate respirator dust masks
 - * 1-3 mm thickness
 - * No surgical masks
- Two pairs kitchen gloves
 - * Durable for multiple uses
 - * Remove from packaging
- · One pair work gloves
 - * Cotton with leather palm or all leather

Nursery Reopening

Beginning on Sunday, May 9, nursery for children age 5 and under will be available during the 10:30 worship service. The Reopening Team has put together the following health and safety guidelines for the nursery:

Cleaning and Disinfecting:

- The nursery and child care areas will be cleaned after each use by the custodial staff
- Staff and volunteers will remove all items from rooms that cannot be easily disinfected
- Toys and supplies will be disinfected after use
- Bedding and nap supplies will be washed
- Washable bottles/cups will be used for water instead of the water fountain
- Regular handwashing for workers and children

Safety Protocols:

- All adults will wear masks at all times. Masks are not required for children 2 years old and under, and masks are optional for children ages 2-5 years old in the nursery
- Social distance of 6 feet will be maintained as much as possible
- Parents/guardians will sign children in and out at the nursery
- Parents/guardians will maintain social distance of 6 feet during drop off and pick up
- Child care workers will maintain accurate attendance records of each class
- Those who feel sick or who have been exposed to or tested positive for COVID-19 should stay home
- Safe Sanctuary guidelines will continue to be followed

This small chart compares contributions for the first quarter of 2020 and the first quarter of 2021.
