RETURNING TO IN-PERSON WORSHIP

We are excited to return to in-person worship services beginning Sunday, March 7, at 10:30am. After many months apart, we will gather in person, but the ways we gather and move around the space may be different than usual. Please take note of these instructions for worshipping in person:

Parking

Park in Pine Street or Maple Street lots or along the street. Parking on Spring Street is reserved for those who need access to the elevator.

Entrance

Enter the building through the Pine Street stairway entrance or Maple Street entrance. Ascend the stairs and stop at the Welcome Table in the narthex to register attendance.

<u>Offering</u>

Place offering in the wooden box in the narthex before entering the sanctuary, or place offering in the wooden box at side doors when exiting the sanctuary.

Seating

Enter the sanctuary through the center doors. Ushers will seat worshippers at available pews to ensure social distancing. Households should sit and stay together during the entire service.

Elevator Use

Park or drop off at the Spring Street connector entrance. Enter the connector through the Spring Street door. Stop at the Welcome Table to register attendance. Proceed to the 3rd floor on the elevator. Enter the sanctuary through the door closest to the elevator. Ushers will seat worshippers in available pews near the front door.

<u>Exit</u>

Ushers will dismiss pews from back to front. Exit down outer aisles and out the side doors at the back of the sanctuary. Descend the stairs toward Pine Street or Maple Street doors. Exit to the parking area.

Safety Procedures

Masks or cloth face coverings are required during the entire service, including before and after the service, even outside. All households and family groups should stay at least 6 feet apart. Please be especially mindful of this as you move around the facility and enter and exit the building. There will be no group singing. There will be limited access to the other parts of the building. Everyone is required to register their attendance. Reservations are strongly recommended for planning purposes. All safety procedures are still required of those who have received a vaccination. Those who are sick, vulnerable, or unable to wear a mask should stay safe at home.

Online worship services will continue to be available, and those who do not feel comfortable gathering in person are encouraged to worship at home. We will livestream the sanctuary services and those at home can participate in real time on Sundays at 10:30.

- 1 backpack (new or gently used)
- 1 12" ruler
- 2 boxes chalk
- 1 compass for math
- 1 protractor
- 1 10-12 pack pens (blue or black ink)
- 1 10-12 pack pencils
- 1 pack erasers
- 2 pencil sharpeners
- 3 spiral notebooks (70 ct.)
- 1 small Bible (new or used)

Instructions

- Remove price tags from all items
- Place school supplies inside backpack
- Use only quantities listed (note that 10 or 12 count packs of pens and pencils are allowed)
- No substitutions or additional items are allowed due to Customs regulations, including notes, cards, photos, religious tracts, food items, or anything else not on the list
