



Attention: It is important to note that Holston Conference United Methodist Women have two logos. First, we have our "primary" logo which is the UMW logo with the cross and the flame (Faith, Hope and Love in Action written underneath). Then we have the "secondary" logo, our "theme" logo. All too often we are disassociating ourselves from the UMW "primary" logo by not using it. It is especially important that we use it, respecting the UMW universal theme which is Faith, Hope, Love in Action. Thank you for using both logos throughout your new year.

THE EMBLEM

The emblem for **UNITED METHODIST WOMEN** affirms our continuity as women organized for mission. Its symbolism affirms our continuous growth and renewal.

The emblem for **UNITED METHODIST WOMEN**, as well as that for the church, combines the cross and a flame, symbolizing the Holy Spirit. The cross and flame are ancient symbols of the church, dating back to the days of Christ and the Pentecost. Each evokes images of sacrifice, witness, and service. Both remind us of the opportunities and obligations of discipleship. Paul's ancient words to Timothy have fresh and contemporary meaning:

I now remind you to stir into flame the gift of God which is with you.

II Timothy 1:6, NEB

As part of the emblem for **UNITED METHODIST WOMEN,** these symbols remind us of our **PURPOSE** of helping women to grow as persons and in community in their understanding of and willingness to participate in service for the church at home and abroad, and in organizations of women for mission service and support in many areas of need.

Our heritage is one of sacrifice, witness, and service. The emblem serves as a continuing reminder of both opportunity and obligation.

The shape of the emblem is likewise symbolic. It is fluid and free flowing, suggesting change and mobility. As organized groups of women, this has been our heritage - often as the forefront of movements of change, at times supporting the projects initiated by others, but always aware of the times and striving to move with them rather than be overwhelmed by them.

As **UNITED METHODIST WOMEN,** let us think on the meaning of our emblem and endeavor to use our abilities and opportunities to grow and to help others!



- 6. Business:
 - a. Report of UMW Executive Committee meeting.
 - b. Treasurer's report
 - c. Service projects
 - d. Other business
- 7. Report from New World Outlook or Response
- 8. Program It is suggested that the Program Leader solicit help from other members of her group. (The circle leader might wish to present all of the choices of program material to the circle members and let it be their choice which material is chosen.)
- 9. Benediction

(Suggestion: have the group form a "friendship circle" and give the following benediction together.)

"The Lord watch between me and thee, while we are absent one from another." Genesis 31:49

B. Duties of Circle Leader:

1. Attend the monthly Executive Committee Meeting or send a representative from her group. Serve as a member of the Executive, Program, and Finance Projects and Goals Committee.

- 2. Select a member to be responsible for:
 - a. Telephone
 - Call to remind members of General and Circle meetings
 - 2) Make all reservations
 - b. Visitation: To see that all shut-ins are contacted once a month by a visit, phone call, or a card, and especially remembered on holidays.
 - c. Treasurer
 - 1) Collect pledges and keep accurate records
 - 2) Transfer money to the UMW Unit Treasurer promptly each month
 - 3) Transfer project money to Unit Treasurer or disburse directly to project for local missions
 - d. "Sunshine"
 - 1) Collect and maintain offerings for miscellaneous needs for support of members or others.
 - 2) Disburse these offerings as needed or directed by group members.
 - 4. Obtain meeting place for monthly circle meetings.
 - 5. Select, with help from members, service projects or mission projects in community.
 - 6. Encourage attendance at circle and general meetings.
 - 7. In October, every-other-year, select leader, co-leader, and program leader for the following 2 years.
 - 8. Let Membership Chairman know when you add new members or lose them due to moving.


