CALL TO WORSHIP

People: The brilliant Light of Hope is with us!

PRAYER of CONFESSION and ASSURANCE of PARDON

Leader: We thank You, loving God, that we have been baptized into the death and resurrection of the Messiah.

Leader: For the sake of the Lamb, forgive us.

People: Come into our lives today, so that we may learn to live as disciples of Jesus, sharing Your love with all people, at all times and in all places.

Leader: God has shined His light upon us! Christ is risen! Death has been swallowed up in victory! Hear and believe the good news of the resurrection:

People: In the powerful name of the risen Christ, our sins are forgiven. Glory be to God! Amen.
