## GREETING

### CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: God, who gave us the Son, now gives us the Spirit of divine truth and power.

### PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Leader: We confess that often our thoughts and actions separate us from what You desire for our lives.

**People: We confess our need for the Spirit to transform our judgement into compassion, our suspicion into understanding, our fear into trust, our anger into reason, our conflict into peace, and our divisiveness into unity.**

Leader: Have mercy on us, O God, and make our hearts one with Yours.

**People: Have mercy on us and transform our lives, that we may boldly witness to Your saving grace, and worthily magnify Your holy name.**

Leader: God, Who hears our prayer, has set us free from the bondage of sin and calls us to a life of witness and service. Sisters and brothers, hear and believe the good news of the Gospel:

**People: In Jesus Christ, by the power of the Spirit, we are forgiven. Thanks be to God. AMEN**
