People: Forgive us when our attitudes, actions, and words hurt rather than heal.

Leader: Forgive us when we fail to pick up our cross and follow You.

People: Father, give us hearts of grateful love to acknowledge Your presence in our lives. Take away our darkness and make us channels of Your light and love.
